ELCA Churchwide Assembly Elections

Yehiel Curry was elected July 30 to serve a six-year term as presiding bishop of the ELCA.

Lucille “CeCee” Mills was elected Aug. 1 to serve a six-year term as secretary of the ELCA.



2025 Churchwide Assembly Elections

Yehiel Curry elected presiding bishop of the ELCA

Speaking to the assembly after his election, Curry reflected on his membership at Shekinah Chapel in Riverdale, Ill., where he eventually became a lay mission developer. During that time he participated in the Theological Education for Emerging Ministries program, which prepares individuals for ordained ministry in the ELCA, with a focus on emerging ministry contexts like ethnic-specific, multicultural, and both rural and urban settings. He spoke to the assembly about his initial hesitation in accepting that first ministry role.

“I’m what a return on your investment looks like,” he said. “Perhaps I’m out there in one of you. I never saw myself as good enough, so for two years, I said no. I finally said yes. When I said yes, your support, this church’s support, of that ministry meant everything. So if you want to know what your benevolence dollars look like, it looks like me. And I want to say thank you. Thank you for your investment.”

Lucille “CeCee” Mills elected secretary of the ELCA

“I do believe it’s a new season for our church,” Mills said. “I do believe that the reason why I, an African American woman, [can stand] before you with no degrees in a church that loves to have people who are educated, is because you saw the gifts and potential in me. I celebrate with you that we listen to God’s call and that we will become God’s beloved community.”

The elections took place during the 2025 ELCA Churchwide Assembly held July 28–August 2 at the Phoenix Convention Center, Arizona.



Trauma-Informed Outreach and Ministry Event

August 25, 2025

There's no shortage of pain in the pews. People are tired, isolated, grieving, skeptical or simply done. And if we want to be effective evangelists in this generation, we need to shift our mindset from programs to presence, from pressure to pastoral care. That's why the ELCA Evangelism Network is hosting a vital conversation on Monday, August 25 at 3:00 p.m. ET:

"Trauma-Informed Outreach and Ministry: Pathways to Healing Engagement for the Hurt, Burnt-Out, or Checked-Out."

Led by the Rev. Carla Christopher, this session will walk us through what it means to be a trauma-informed congregation; how we can be safe,

compassionate, and healing spaces for those carrying invisible wounds. This is essential work for anyone doing outreach, preaching, caregiving, or leadership in today's post-pandemic, high-anxiety, emotionally complex world. You'll learn:

- How trauma shows up in spiritual life and church participation
- Ways to engage without re-triggering or overwhelming
- Models of ministry that center restoration, not recruitment
